

Meeting discussion points outside of Action Committee activity:

- **Community Partners meeting:** It was unanimously agreed that the Community Partners meeting on 11/12 was a great success, with numerous community sectors offering support of DAY's initiatives. Ideas for followup included reaching out to community members that offered to help promote the Safe Homes, Chris Herren, and Project Purple initiatives. Specifically, it was agreed that the Prevention Coordinator should reach out to St George Church, 1st Congregational Church, and the Soccer Club of Guilford, all of which had agreed to invite their organization's parents to take the Safe Homes pledge. It was also agreed that DAY's youth members will visit multiple community groups in town to promote Project Purple and gain community buy-in and support. Youth will begin with the Women in Science Club at GHS in December and will visit groups including St George, First Congregational Church, Unity, and SADD. Lastly, members emphasized the importance of promptly reaching out to community partners that attended the meeting while DAY's initiatives are fresh in their minds.
- **Chris Herren and Project Purple:** It was agreed that DAY will need a comprehensive publicity plan to ensure DAY reaches as many communities members as possible with the Chris Herren Presentation and Project Purple. Publicity ideas for Project Purple included selling t-shirts at GHS the week before the Chris Herren presentation and promoting Project Purple through the TVs at GHS, social media and flyers.
- **CADCA Mid-Year Training:** DAY's youth members will have the opportunity to attend CADCA's Mid-Year Training Institute, which will be held in August in Indianapolis, IN. DAY members have previously attended the February CADCA Forum but not the Mid-Year training, which will serve as a new experience. Youth members were extremely enthusiastic about attending with a group of DAY youth and some adults that will supervise. It was agreed to check with the finance committee regarding budget for the training.

Action Committees:

Community Values Youth/AC1 -
