

# VAPING 101:

What every parent and teacher needs to know about e-cigarettes and the risks for youth.

Guilford parents, educators & adults are invited to join an important presentation given by the **Yale University Tobacco Research in Youth (TRY)** group on vaping and the risks for our youth.

Over the past five years, the TRY group has been conducting lab studies as well as surveys in several Connecticut schools to assess perceptions of e-cigarettes, rates of use, risk factors for initiation, and marketing effects. The data they collect allows them to help the FDA create regulations regarding e-cigarettes that will have a substantial impact on adolescent health promotion.

After this 30-minute presentation, State Representative Sean Scanlon will offer an update on what the legislature has done regarding vaping. An administrator from Guilford Public Schools will also be present to answer questions.
